If any cabin spaces that were arranged to be used remain unoccupied during your stay, you will still be charged for cabin spaces.

Kitchen Regulations

1. **Only your group's cooks are allowed in the kitchen.** No children please
2. Ask before using any equipment you are unfamiliar with.
3. **Clean all equipment, place settings, and fixtures used. PLEASE CLEAN WELL.**
4. **Empty Kitchen/Dining Hall trash cans.**
5. Please do not use any Camp food or paper products unless arrangements are made ahead of time.
6. **Please leave everything as you found it when you are done – including tables and chairs in the Dining Room**

General Regulations and Standards

We ask for your cooperation of the following regulations for safety and the promotion of the Christian testimony of our camp.

1. **It is the responsibility of those in charge of the group coming to camp to ensure each guest understands these standards and abides by them.**
2. Each group needs at least one person over 18 years of age for each 10 people under 18 years of age.
3. **All areas used by your group need to be left in the condition in which you found them. There will be a \$50.00/hour cleaning fee charged for any excessive messes left behind.**
Signs will be posted in each area/building as to what is expected to be done at the end of your stay!
4. Observe and obey safety signs posted at the waterslide, Oceanwave, pond, etc. **No one under 18 should be at the pond without an adult present and paying attention – There is NO SWIMMING allowed.**
5. Please respect our neighbors and keep noise/music quiet during early morning or late evening hours.
6. Roughhousing, wrestling, water fights etc. need to be done outside.
7. Please do not rearrange beds/**mattresses**, cabins, chapel pews, game room without permission from the director.
8. Return all sports equipment and other camp material to the same place you found them when you are finished.
9. **No Pets will be permitted on camp! (any animals found on camp will be charged \$100/day and must leave immediately)**
10. Guys are not permitted in the assigned girls' areas and girls are not permitted in the assigned guys' areas.
11. Tobacco, e-cigs, alcoholic beverages, fireworks, recreational drugs are not allowed on camp property. No smoking (period) will be permitted on camp property. We also request that you do not bring gum (gum gets found in the most interesting places!)
12. **NO food in any buildings except the Dining Hall!**
13. Shoes need to be worn outside the cabins except on the waterslide and in the bathhouse.
14. Do not leave lights on or doors open when a building is not occupied and make sure things are closed up and turned off overnight. Please also make sure to do these things before you leave camp at the end of your stay.
15. **Payment for any damages done to the property or materials other than normal wear and tear is the responsibility of the group using the facilities and will be added into your invoice upon camp inspection after your departure.** No trees are to be cut down; this includes branches.

Bliss Summit Bible Camp and BCM International and any personnel thereof are hereby released from any and all liability for or by reason of any injury or damage of any nature whatsoever which may be sustained by any member of the group using the camp.
